ANNEX No. 1 TO DECISION NO. 9/2021 STUDENT TESTING FOR THE PRESENCE OF SARS-COV-2

Article 1

The text of Article 3, Paragraph 3 and 4 is deleted and replaced by the following:

3. *If the student passes the POC antigen test for the presence of SARS-CoV-2 virus antigen in the contractual sampling centre, he/she is obliged to prove to the employees of the contractual sampling centre with a BUT student ID card, identity card and health insurance card. In the case of registration with VZP General Health Insurance), students from EU countries also prove themselves with a confirmation of registration or an appropriate VZP card.*
4. *Students from EU member states are obliged to register with the General Health Insurance Company of the Czech Republic (VZP ČR), if they are not already registered there, as soon as possible or immediately after returning to BUT from abroad. This is the registration of a foreign insured person registered with VZP ČR as a Czech auxiliary health insurance company; when applying for registration, the student submits the identity card, the European Health Insurance Card and a confirmation of study at BUT. The reason for registration is the need to provide the necessary health care for students from EU member states in the event of a positive antigen test or COVID-19 disease in the Czech Republic. Students from EU countries state the number of the insured when taking the test after registration with VZP ČR at the health service provider included in the network of sampling centres and in the contractual sampling centre.*

Article 2

1. The other provisions of this BUT internal standard remain unchanged in their original version.
2. This Annex shall enter into force on the date specified in its title
