DECISION NO. 8/2023

TUITION FEES FOR DEGREE PROGRAMMES TAUGHT IN ENGLISH IN THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2024/2025

Article 1

Subject matter

 Pursuant to Section 58, Paragraph 4 of Act no. 111/1998 Coll. Concerning universities and a change in and amendments to other acts, and to Article 31, Paragraph 1, Item d) of the BUT Statutes, and to Article 9 of Annex 4 to the BUT Statutes, this internal regulation sets the tuition fees for study in the English language of accredited degree programmes.

Article 2

Tuition fees

- 1. In an accredited Bachelor's degree programme, the tuition fee to be paid shall amount to:
 - a) 1,800 EUR per academic year for students who are citizens of an EU member state;
 - b) 9,200 EUR per academic year for students who are citizens a country which is not an EU member state;
- 2. In an accredited follow-up Master's degree programme, the tuition fee to be paid shall amount to:
 - a) 2,290 EUR per academic year for students who are citizens of an EU member state;
 - b) 9,700 EUR per academic year for students who are citizens a country which is not an EU member state;
- 3. In an accredited doctoral degree programme, the tuition fee to be paid shall amount to:
 - a) 4,490 EUR per academic year for students who are citizens of an EU member state;
 - b) 9,900 EUR (234,000 CZK) per academic year for students who are citizens a country which is not an EU member state;

Article 3

Final provisions

- 1. A student must pay a tuition fee by bank transfer into the account of the BUT Faculty of Business and Management. The account number, payment details (variable symbol) as well as the maturity date can be found in the call to pay the fee or in the agreement about tuition fee to be paid.
- 2. The fees listed in Article 2 may also be paid in CZK. When transforming the amounts from EUR into CZK, the ČNB exchange rate will be used of 01. 09. 2024
- 3. The amounts of payments as shown in Article 2 will be binding for students who start their studies in the academic year 2024/2025 lasting the standard length of studies without interruption. In the following academic years, the ČNB exchange rate of 1st September of each current year will be used for transforming the amounts into CZK.
- 4. Provided that all the study obligation for the 1st year have been fulfilled, a student of a Bachelor programme who is a citizen of a country which is not an EU member state may apply for a reduction of the fee on registration for the 2nd year of study.
- 5. This internal regulation comes into force on the date included in its header.
