Article 1 Subject and purpose of the decision

 Based on the BUT Rector's Decision in connection with the spread of the coronavirus SARS-CoV-2, the conditions of teaching and operation of FA BUT are being adjusted. The goal of FA BUT is to protect students and employees and at the same time enable teaching in accordance with the valid accreditation of study programs.

Article 2 Notification obligation when COVID-19 disease is detected

- 1. Employees are obliged immediately notify to the HR Department of the BUT FA that they have been ordered quarantine or isolation in connection with the COVID-19 disease. The notification obligation is made via the faculty email to the address bednarova@fa.vutbr.cz.
- 2. Students are obliged immediately notify to the Study Department of the BUT FA that they have been ordered quarantine or isolation in connection with the COVID-19 disease. The notification obligation is made via the faculty email to the address <a href="https://havbord.com/havbord-nature-natur

Article 3 Obligation of the employee to be tested for the presence of SARS-CoV-2

- 1. The personal presence of an employee at all BUT workplaces is allowed under the condition to the employee has undergone testing with a negative result in the last 7 calendar days or is covered by an exemption from the testing obligation.
- 2. The employee shall fulfil his obligation to take the test referred to in point 1, Article 3 in one of the following ways:
 - a. passing the RT-PCR test for the presence of SARS-CoV-2 virus performed by a health service provider included in the network of sampling centres, the result of which was inserted into the corresponding module in the IS,

- b. passing the POC antigen test for the presence of SARS-CoV-2 virus antigen performed by a health service provider included in the network of sampling centres, the result of which was entered into the corresponding module in the IS,
- c. passing a preventive test to determine the presence of SARS-CoV-2 virus antigen in the faculty premises performed by means of a sampling kit.
- 3. Before entering the faculty, the employee may use the option of self-testing according to point c of the previous paragraph in the following way:
 - a. pick up the test kit at the reception,
 - b. in stated areas, perform the test according to the instructions,
 - c. wait for the test results (approx. 15 min),
 - d. in case of a negative result, the employee can continue to the building and pass the test to the Building Maintenance. It disposes of the material accordingly and registers the result in the IS.
 - e. in the case of a positive test, the employee eaves the faculty building and proceeds in accordance with Article 4 of the BUT Rector's Decision No. 8/2021 (Procedure for determining a positive test result),
 - f. in case of an inconclusive result, the test is repeated.
- 4. Only employees who are obliged to take the test are entitled to get the test, according to point 2 of this article, once every 7 days.
- 5. The obligation to undergo the SARS-CoV-2 test in accordance with paragraph 1 of this Article shall not apply to employees who:
 - a. on the basis of an agreement with the employer, perform their work outside the place of permanent performance of work (home-office),
 - b. have undergone laboratory-confirmed COVID-19 disease, have expired in accordance with the applicable emergency measure of the Ministry, show no signs of COVID-19 disease, and since the first positive RT-PCR test for SARS-CoV-2 or POC antigen test for the presence of SARS-CoV-2 antigen has not occurred for more than 180 days,
 - c. has undergone a vaccination against COVID-19 and demonstrate that
 - at least 22 days have passed since the first dose of vaccine was applied in the case of a two-dose schedule according to the SPC, but not more than 90 days if the second dose has not been applied
 - ii) at least 22 days have passed since the first dose of vaccine was applied in the case of a two-dose schedule according to the SPC, but not more than 9 months if the second dose was applied, or
 - iii) at least 14 days but not more than 9 months have passed since the dose of the vaccine was applied in case of the single-dose schedule according to the SPC, and the vaccinated person does not show any symptoms of COVID-19. '

- d. do not perform work at the employer's workplace due to obstacles to work on the part of the employer.
- 6. BUT employees are obliged to record data and documents according to par. 5 point a), b) and c) in the relevant modules in the BUT IS 2, whereby:
 - a. the exception under paragraph 2 (a) b) the employee documents the certificate issued by the health service provider,
 - b. the exception according to art. 2 point c the employee is documented by a certificate of the Ministry.

Article 4 Rules for entering the FA BUT building and staying indoors

- 1. Access to the building will be possible only through the main entrance from Poříčí Street; in case of arrival by car, it will be possible to enter the courtyard of the faculty from Bělidla street it is necessary to report to the reception immediately after arrival and use the card for entrance.
- 2. Employees, students and other persons with symptoms of a viral infectious disease (eg fever, cough, dyspnoea, sudden loss of taste and smell, etc.) are not allowed to enter the building.
 - Only students whose personal presence is not prohibited by a measure of the Ministry of Health of the Czech Republic and who have also undergone testing for the presence of SARS-CoV-V virus or SARS-CoV-2 virus antigen with a negative result in the last 7 calendar days or are exempted from the testing obligation may enter the buildings of the BUT Faculty of Architecture. The procedure for testing students for the presence of SARS-CoV-2 is governed by the BUT Rector's relevant decision.
- 3. Students are obliged to provide a declaration every day before entering the BUT FA building that they do not have symptoms of a viral infectious disease and that they have not been ordered quarantine or isolation. In the case the student has already suffered from the disease, he declares that he has been free of symptoms for at least 3 days and that his isolation has ended before today according to the actual regulations. The declaration is filled in electronically in the BUT information system, or at the address http://vut.cz/bezinfekcnost. All declarations are archived.
- 4. If employees have symptoms of a viral infectious disease, they are obliged to immediately contact their superior manager, who, in agreement with the employee, will establish appropriate preventive measures to ensure the training and protection of the health of employees and other persons.
- 5. In the common areas of the BUT FA building, employees, students and other persons are obliged to keep a mutual distance of at least 2 meters.
- 6. Indoors of the BUT FA building, employees, students and other persons are obliged to use respiratory protective equipment (nose, mouth), which is a respirator or similar device (always without exhalation valve) meeting at least all technical conditions and requirements (for

- the product), including a filtration efficiency of at least 94% according to relevant standards (eg FFP2, CN 95), which prevent the spread of droplets.
- 7. Employees, students and other persons in the areas of the FA BUT building are obliged to perform hand disinfection when entering buildings, classrooms and library.
- 8. The provision of respiratory protective equipment for employees who work with other employees at the usual workplace shall be ensured in the required amount by FA BUT.

Article 5 Solving students and candidates issues

- 1. Students and candidates for study still solve their issues with the Study Department of FA BUT by phone or e-mail. Only in necessary cases they can come to the study department in person at the specified date.
- 2. Ordinary study administration will be handled electronically or by post (eg confirmation of study, etc. will be sent by post or via the BUT IS at the student's request).

Article 6 Teaching organization

- FA BUT carries out education in such a way that the goals of accredited study programs or the subject taught are fulfilled, with the application of distance elements of teaching in accordance with the regulations of superior bodies and to a reasonable extent corresponding to objective external circumstances
- 2. Further details and additional rules on the organization of teaching are governed by the BUT Rector's or Vice-Dean for study relevant regulations.

Article 7 Institutional arrangements

1. The faculty bodies will act as needed and in accordance with the current instructions of the BUT management and the government of the Czech Republic.

Article 8 Final provisions

- 1. This decision shall enter into force on 15.06.2021.
- 2. The measure shall be valid until further notice.
- 3. Other are governed by the BUT Rector's relevant regulations.
