## **DECISION NO. 15/2020**

# TUITION FEES FOR DEGREE PROGRAMMES TAUGHT IN ENGLISH IN THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2021/2022

#### Article 1

#### **Subject matter**

 Pursuant to Section 58, Paragraph 4 of Act no. 111/1998 Coll. Concerning universities and a changes in and amendments to other acts, to Article 31, Paragraph 1, Item d) of the BUT Statutes, and to Article 9 of Annex 4 to the BUT Statutes, this internal regulation sets the tuition fees for study in the English language of accredited degree programmes.

#### Article 2

#### **Tuition fees**

- 1. In an accredited Bachelor's degree programme, the tuition fee to be paid shall amount to:
  - a) 1,500 EUR (39,000 CZK) per academic year for students who are citizens of an EU member state;
  - b) 8,000 EUR (208,000 CZK) per academic year for students who are not citizens of an EU member state:
- 2. In an accredited follow-up Master's degree programme, the tuition fee to be paid shall amount to:
  - a) 1,950 EUR (50,700 CZK) per academic year for students who are citizens of an EU member state;
  - b) 2,950 EUR (76,700 CZK) per academic year for students who are not citizens of an EU member state;
- 3. In an accredited doctoral degree programme, the tuition fee to be paid shall amount to:
  - a) 3,900 EUR (101,400 CZK) per academic year for students who are citizens of an EU member state;
  - b) 9,000 EUR (234,000 CZK) per academic year for students who are not citizens of an EU member state;

### Article 3

## **Final provisions**

- 1. A student must pay a tuition fee by bank transfer into the account of the BUT Faculty of Business and Management. The account number, payment details (variable symbol) and maturity date are part of a decision or agreement about tuition fee to be paid.
- 2. This internal regulation comes into force on the date included in its header.
